#### 1. Description of the assessment and use in the program

The major part of a required culminating activity is the assemblage of artifacts that are aimed at demonstrating proficiencies with the framework of the ELCC Standards. The selection process and requisite reflections allow students to constantly be mindful of what artifacts of their work best illustrate these proficiencies. Some artifacts indeed cover several, if not all, of the ELCC Standards. Only through the student's self-assessment and subsequent reflections can we be sure that the appropriate standards are being addressed. To assist students in the collection, assessment and reflection on artifacts germane to their self-study they are encouraged to utilize technology as well as many of the ELCC Standards in their Learning Plan that align with the project's stated goals and outcomes. The artifacts must align with the stated areas of growth as outlined in their Learning Plan.

- Without a deep and abiding level of content knowledge a student cannot successfully perform the myriad steps to discerning the artifacts that exemplify the proficiency of the ELCC Standards.
- The professional assemblage and reflection on the required artifacts allows Keene State College Instructors to assess the student in the realms of professional knowledge, skills and dispositions and if these are not present it will be documented and addressed at its initial stages.
- The entire Artifact Collection and Reflection process is focused on the student's need for authentic learning opportunities.
